Welcome to Lisse, a picturesque village also known as the “heart of the bulb-growing region”. Lisse has traditionally been central to bulb-growing, not just due to its location, but also because of its role in the cultivation of, and trade in, bulbs. To this day Lisse is still home to a thriving collection of bulb fields, major bulb auctions and bulb export businesses.

But Lisse has lots more to offer. The local attractions include a (partly covered and largely pedestrianised) shopping centre, which boasts almost 200 shops and a diverse range of restaurants, cafes, lunchrooms and terraces. As an added bonus, parking is free of charge almost everywhere in the village. These splendid shopping facilities attract visitors from far and wide.

What’s more, Lisse offers plenty of other attractions, such as the Black Tulip Museum, the Keukenhof bulb park, the Kasteel Keukenhof estate and the restored donjon ‘t Huys Dever. All of these attractions are within walking distance of the centre of the village.
